Exhibits will be received Wednesday, September 25, from 10 a.m. until 8 p.m. and Thursday, September 26, from 7 until 9 a.m., at which time judging will begin. Exhibits must be picked up at 5 p.m. on Sunday, September 29, but absolutely NOT BEFORE 5 p.m. Unclaimed items will remain at the Fairgrounds for a limited number of days. Fair personnel are not responsible for unclaimed items.

General instructions and rules:

- 1. Pictures must be framed and mounted with wire, secure for hanging.**
Exception: Work done on canvasses designed not to be framed (such as Gallery wrap and Convexo) are acceptable provided all visible surfaces incorporate the painted image and the work is securely wired for hanging.
2. No string, tape or glue for hanging will be accepted.
3. No wet pictures will be accepted.
4. Work more than two years old, or if it has been shown in the Cochise County Fair before, will not be accepted.
5. **Exhibitors are only allowed one entry in each Lot, but may enter as many Lots as they choose.**
6. Print information on entry form clearly and provide a contact telephone number.
7. No nudes.
8. Maximum size including frame:
Adult Art: shall not exceed 47" x 36".
Youth Art: shall not exceed 36" in either length or width.
9. Youth are welcome to enter as adults if they wish to do so.

ALL ENTRY FORMS AND EXHIBITOR'S TAGS MUST SHOW DEPARTMENT L AND THE DIVISION THAT BEST DESCRIBES YOUR ART EXPERIENCE. If you do not indicate the division on both the entry form and the tag, your entry **will not** be judged. Adults and Youth use the same classes and lots.

ADULTS

DIVISION A	BEGINNER (those experienced in art under 3 years)
DIVISION B	INTERMEDIATE (those experienced in art between 3 & 5 years)
DIVISION C	ADVANCED (those experienced in art more than 5 years)
DIVISION D	PROFESSIONAL (those teaching or selling art work and receiving \$2,000 or more of annual income from the sale of their art)

DIVISION E	Grades 1 through 4

This sheet must be signed by the exhibitor as verification of your willingness for Superintendents to give out this information.

PREMIUM AWARDS: First place \$4.00 Second place \$3.00

SPECIAL AWARDS: Best of Show ribbon may be given for an outstanding exhibit for adults and youth. Best of Show ribbons may also be given for outstanding work in Graphic Arts and in Sculpture.

POPULAR AWARD: A Rosette ribbon will be given to the Adult Art work and to the Youth Art work receiving the most popular votes during the Fair. Popular votes cast by viewers will cease at 12:00 p.m. (noon) Sunday, September 29, and the winner will be announced as soon as the votes are tallied.
