Exhibits will be received Wednesday, September 25 from 10 a.m. until 8 p.m. and Thursday, September 26 from 7 a.m. until 9 a.m. Exhibits must be picked up at 5 p.m. on Sunday, September 29, but absolutely NOT BEFORE 5 p.m. Unclaimed items will remain at the Fairgrounds for a limited number of days. Fair personnel are not responsible for unclaimed items.

General instructions and rules:

1. No entries which have previously won any place in any category at the Cochise Country Fair within the last five years may be submitted. Judges may use their discretion in making awards and have the right to disqualify an entry, which they determine to be out of category, does not comply with the rules, or is inappropriate for the exhibit.
2. Entries which have a date/timestamp on the print will be disqualified.
3. Minimum print size is 8" x 10" up to a maximum print size of 16" x 20" inches. All prints must be matted, unless printed on canvas or metal.. Prints also need to be mounted so that the photograph will stay rigid when hung. **Do not use double-sided tape or rubber cement.** These cannot stand up to the heat in the exhibit building. **Prints in frames will not be accepted. Exhibitor's name, mailing address, the class and lot numbers, as well as the title of the photograph, must be put on the backside of the mount.**
4. Tape the exhibitor's tag to the back of the photograph by the string, so that the tag can be seen.
5. If it is not immediately evident which way the photo should be displayed please indicate "TOP" and "BOTTOM" on the back of the print.

PREMIUM AWARDS: First place \$4.00 Second place \$3.00

SPECIAL AWARDS: Best of Show ribbon may be given for an outstanding print in each class.

POPULAR AWARD: A Rosette ribbon will be given to the print receiving the most popular votes during the Fair. Popular votes cast by viewers will cease at 9:00 p.m. Saturday, September 28, and the winner will be announced Sunday morning.
